CULINARY CORNER

Low Salt Cucumbers (ogorki malosolone)

Ingredients:

Cucumbers - small and firm
Boiled and cooled water
Salt - two tablespoons per 1.5 liters of water
One Garlic bulb per large jar
Horseradish - for centimeters of root
Dill - one bunch

Preparing the cucumbers:

- 1. Wash cucumbers and place in a large jar. Also place the dill, garlic, and long strips of horseradish root around the cucumbers in the jar
- 2. Dissolve the salt in water and pour in jar to cover contents completely and close the lid
- 3. Put the jars aside in a cool dark place where they are not exposed to sunlight. After 3 days the cucumbers will turn yellowish. They should be perfect.
- 4. Each additional day, they become more pickled and sour
