NOVEMBER 12, SATURDAY – CELEBRATION OF POLISH INDEPENDENCE DAY

Our traditional Independence Day bonfire will take place on Saturday, November 12, from 5 pm to 9 pm, at the Korean House picnic area, 10569 Collierville Road, Collierville, TN 38017. The Polish flag will be visible at the entrance and we will begin with our Polish anthem. The Polish-American Society provides drinks, traditional pea soup and warm mulled wine. We invite participants to bring a dish or dessert to the common table. The program of the meeting includes a traditional bonfire and joint singing of patriotic songs from the old days and other famous Polish hits. The event is financed from the PAS budget.

DECEMBER 10 - POLISH WIGILIA

This year we are returning to the tradition of organizing a joint Christmas Eve dinner. It will be held on Saturday, December 10 at the Bert Ferguson Community Center, Cordova. Admission will be free for members of the organization, for non-members it will be \$ 40. As before, the organization will provide basic Christmas Eve dishes. We will ask all participants for other traditional dishes for the Christmas Eve table and help in preparing the Christmas Eve (as was the case in 2019). Traditionally, children of members will receive gift bags. We will inform you by email about the date of applications for participation in the Christmas Eve, the conditions and details of its organization, one month before the date of Christmas Eve.

REPORTS FROM PAST EVENTS

THE JURANDS SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS

This year the Polish American Society held the inaugural competition for the Jurands Scholarship, a program made possible by a grant donated to the Polish American Society by the Jurands, who were among the founders of the Society in 1978 and longtime members. The PAS Board finished evaluation of the scholarship applications in August, and we are pleased to announce the inaugural awardees of the Jurands scholarship: Elizabeth Zabielski Hurlbut, a student at the University of Tennessee Health Sciences Center in Memphis. Christian Zabielski, at University of Tennessee Knoxville.

By unanimous decision the PAS Board allocated a part of the grant to support the education of young members of our Memphis Polish community. The Board also unanimously named the award The Jurand Scholarship, in honor of the benefactors. The Board appointed the Scholarship Council, which determines essay topics for the scholarship competition and evaluates scholarship applications and essays and awards the scholarships to the applicant whose essay receives the most Council votes.

PAS announced the first scholarship competition in May. After the announcement and during the application and adjudication of this year's scholarship, Mr. and Mrs. Jurand made an additional donation to the scholarship fund, enabling PAS to increase the scholarship award.

The PAS Board expresses their heartfelt thanks to everyone who contributed time and effort helping to organize the scholarship program, to members of the Scholarship Council, and especially to the Sponsors.

We look forward to participation by PAS members and students in next year's scholarship competition. Essay topics will be announced in May 2023. Best of luck to all who apply!
