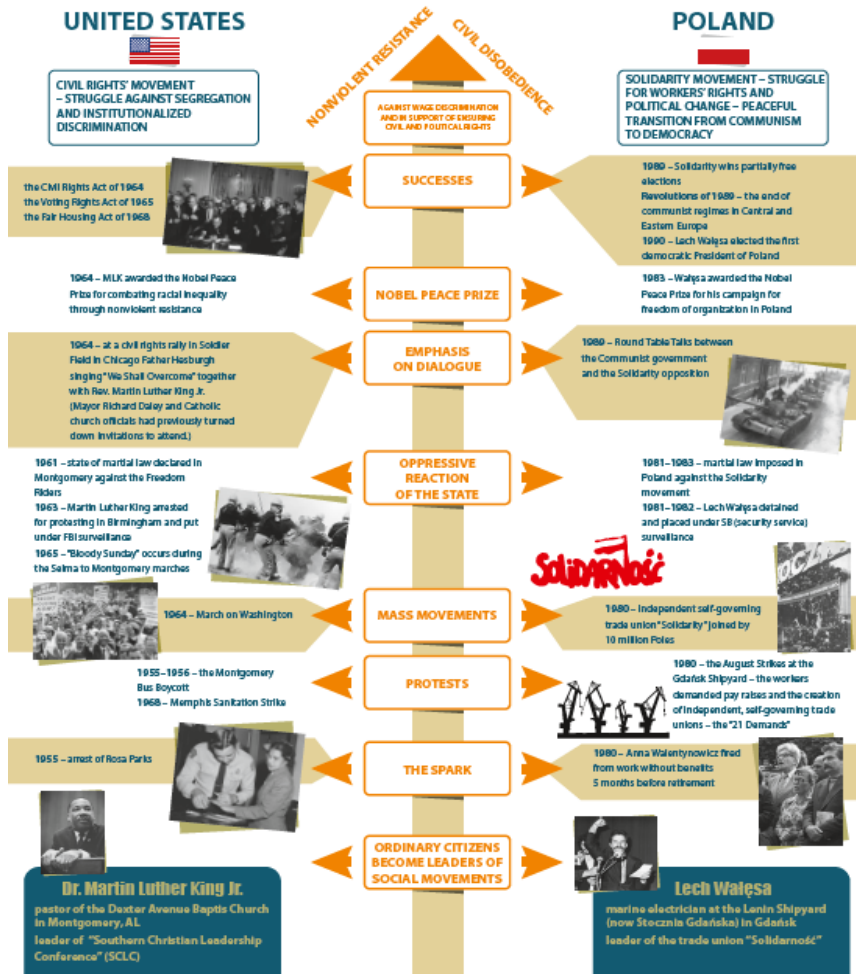

The educational aspect, with an emphasis on the fight against racism, xenophobia and intolerance has been the most important element of our project. In 2019, a group of high-school students from Sopot went to Memphis to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the tragic death of Dr. Martin Luther King. They presented a poster about the heritage of the Polish Solidarity movement and the road to freedom. The aim of this project was to show the similarities between the struggles for democratic ideas in Poland and for the civil rights in the U.S.
